ANITA CHAUDHRY J.

Petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.104 dated 04.12.2014 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District S.A.S. Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that Rachna was married to the petitioner in 2010 and she had written a suicide note on her hand and was reported in the newspaper as well and the deceased had expressed her affection for the husband and it is the uncle who has lodged the FIR and not the father. He urges that the investigation is over and challan has been presented and the petitioner is in custody since last six months and trial will take long time.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the newspaper.

Learned State counsel states that the photograph of the writing on the hand had been sent to the Forensic Science Laboratory and the report is awaited.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no reference to this fact in the challan.

The investigation is over and challan has been submitted. The complaint has been lodged by the uncle. The authenticity of the suicide note would be tested at the trial. The trial will take long time, therefore, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
