Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in Complaint Case No.153 dated 29.7.2011 (Annexure P-1) under Sections 7/16 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Act, 1954 (for short, "the Act") and under Rule 50 of the Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules, 1955, in which the petitioner has been summoned to face trial under Section 16(1)(a) of the Act vide summoning order dated 29.7.2011 (Annexure P-2) passed by JMFC, Amritsar.

Learned State counsel, on instructions Dr. Sukhrao Singh, Food Safety Officer, Jullundhar, submits that pursuant to order dated 5.5.2015 of this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and the trial Court has accepted the bail bonds of the petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 5.5.2015 passed by this Court is made absolute.
