Further states report filed. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner.

The present petition has been filed by petitioner Ramesh Kumar for giving a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate action on the basis of inquiry conducted by the Additional D.C.P., City-II, Amritsar. Learned counsel for the petitioner pleaded that no action has been taken on the basis of said inquiry report, in view of the opinion of District Attorney that the matter was of civil dispute. She contended that Roshan Lal, the brother of the petitioner, who was residing at first floor has committed theft in the premises in possession of the petitioner, which cannot be stated to be a civil dispute. She further contended that two inquiries have been conducted in this case. The first inquiry was conducted by the S.H.O., Police Station Economic Wing, Amritsar and

the second inquiry has been conducted by the A.D.C.P., City-II, wherein the allegations levelled by the petitioner have been substantiated. But in spite of that, no legal action has been taken against said Roshan Lal. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner will be satisfied if the D.C.P. of the concerned area is directed to look into the inquiry reports and to take appropriate legal action in accordance of law.

So, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the inquiry reports and to take the appropriate direction in accordance with law, if any criminal offence is made out.

The needful be done preferably within two months.
