Report dated 27.04.2015 sent by the learned JMIC Jalandhar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioners Parminder Kaur, Sanjeev Kumar Bali, Gurtej Singh and Sarwan Singh as well as of complainant Harpreet Singh it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that there was a pure dispute over money and the same has now been settled between the parties by way of a compromise and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012 (4) RCR CrI. 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and another vs. State of Punjab and others 2007(3) RCR CrI. 1052,** FIR No.97 dated 03.04.2013 under Sections 406, 420 IPC, Police Station, Ramamandi, District Jalandhar City and all other consequential

proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.

Petition stands disposed off.
