This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. praying for the benefit of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.34 dated 22.01.2014, under Section 395 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Kharkhoda, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR in question was registered on the statement of complainant, Bijender S/o Zile Singh, who is stated to run a retailer shop in the fields near the brick kiln, on 20.01.2014 at about 8 PM, 3 persons had come to his shop and on the threat by pointing a revolver a sum of Rs.15,000/-, a purse, 3 mobile phones and some loose coins were taken away and thereafter these 3 persons ran away on their splendor motorcycle.

The present petitioner is stated to have been arrested in the present case on 25.02.2014. Learned State counsel would apprise the Court that the petitioner was also involved in FIR No.29 dated 16.01.2014 under Sections 394/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act and pertaining to that case, one country made pistol was also recovered.

It has gone uncontroverted that co-accused, namely, Anil and Parveen have already been granted the benefit of bail.

Investigation in the present case having been completed, challan was presented on 28.03.2014. State counsel has also apprised the Court that the complainant, namely, Bijender has already been examined by the trial Court.

In the totality of of circumstances, the petitioner is held entitled to the concession of bail.

Accordingly, prayer is allowed.

Petitioner, namely, Deepak alias Dhoni be enlarged on bail subject to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.

Disposed of.
