RAMESHWAR SINGH MALIK, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.74 dated 10.05.2012 under Sections 307, 427, 447, 511, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25, 27, 54, 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that earlier the petitioner was granted bail pending trial. He had been appearing regularly before the learned trial Court on every date of hearing. However, on 26.02.2014, petitioner could not appear before the learned trial Court because of some genuine difficulty, which was beyond his control. He submits that petitioner is ready and willing to surrender before the learned trial Court and will bring all these facts to the notice of learned Court which may be directed to consider the bail application of the petitioner at an early date and decide the same, in accordance with law.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner, present petition is disposed of, with a direction to the learned trial Court that if the

petitioner surrenders within a period of one week from today and files application for bail, the same shall be considered, in view of the totality of facts and circumstances, which may be brought to the notice of learned Court by the petitioner. His application shall be considered and decided at an early date, by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law.

With the abovesaid observations made and directions issued, present petition stands disposed of.
