Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.493 dated 28.12.2014 under Sections 323, 506, 34 IPC (later on added Section 307 IPC) registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

This Court vide order dated 5.5.2015 had granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to his joining investigation and complying the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that pursuant to order dated 5.5.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Ramesh Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and recovery

has been effected from him. He further submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required at this stage.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 5.5.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
