Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioners have approached this Court by way of instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking direction to the official respondents for providing protection to their life and liberty, at the hands of private respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that when the grievance of the petitioners was not being redressed, they finally approached the In charge of Police Post, Sector-45, Chandigarh, by way of complaint dated 25.4.2015 (Annexure P-4), but the same is also pending decision. He further submits that petitioners will be satisfied in case respondents No.2 and 3 are directed to consider and decide the complaint of the petitioners, within a reasonable time.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, lest it should prejudice the rights of either of the parties, Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.2, Station House Officer of concerned Police Station in whose jurisdiction Sector-45, Chandigarh falls as well as In charge of Police Post, Sector-45, Chandigarh, are directed to look into the matter, consider the grievance of the petitioners including threat perception raised by the petitioners in their complaint dated 25.4.2015 (Annexure P-4) and take immediate necessary action by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly in accordance with law but in any case within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh-respondent No.2, is further directed to ensure that an immediate and appropriate action is taken so that the petitioners, who are senior citizens may not face any kind of difficulty including the threat to their life and liberty at the hands of their own son-respondent No.4. Let a strict action, in accordance with law, be taken without any delay.

With the above-said observations made and directions issued, the present petition stands disposed of.
