Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.199 dated 9.11.2014 under Sections 283, 506, 147, 149 IPC registered at Police Station Nagina, District Mewat.

The allegations against the petitioner are that some people, including the petitioners, had blocked the Delhi-Alwar Road at Badhkal Chowk and these persons while taking the stones and pebbles in their hands have threatened the police personnel as well. The police reached there and tried to pacify them but they did not stop. Thus, these persons have obstructed the police from discharging its duty.

During the course of hearing, learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Fateh Singh, has brought to the notice of this Court that in the case in hand, the police has submitted the challan on 11.5.2015 and thereafter, the case was fixed for 3.7.2015 and the petitioners were given notice to that effect, but they have not appeared before the trial Court.

Considering the fact that challan has been presented in the case in hand, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.

However, the petitioners are at liberty to move an appropriate application before the trial Court for grant of regular bail and the trial Court shall consider and decide the same on same date in accordance with law.
