The petitioner was arrested in this case on 15.01.2015.

Investigation is on and it is submitted that some of the accused are yet to be arrested.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR. The complainant made a supplementary statement on 15.01.2015 i.e. one day after the FIR was lodged and in that, named the petitioner alongwith his brother Davinder Singh and two other persons stating that they used to work with Jatender Kumar @ Rana, Rishi Pal Mann and one Vikas. In the supplementary statement also there is no allegation against the petitioner regarding making any phone call or taking money from the complainant as premium for any insurance policy or otherwise. The three persons who were allegedly sitting in a Swift Car and went to the house of the complainant were Dharminder son of Bachhan and Davinder Singh and Ravi Kumar. Petitioner was not among them as well. The complainant

has alleged that Tirloki Nath had made a phone call to him and had lured him into investing money and the complainant paid Rs.6 lacs and two cheques worth Rs.15 lacs.

Since, no role is attributed to the petitioner in the FIR or in the supplementary statement of the complainant and he is in custody for the last more than four months and further investigation is likely to take long to conclude, the other accused having not been arrested, the request of the petitioner is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Hoshiarpur.

Disposed of.
