In the light of the settlement that has arrived between the parties before the Mediator as per report of the Mediation proceedings dated 17.7.2015, whereby, the wife has received till date two demand drafts each of ₹25 lacs totalling to ₹50 lacs and today balance amount of sum of ₹55 lacs by way of post dated cheque No.210773 dated 31.12.2017 which has been received by learned counsel for the complainant Mr. Vinay Pandey, Advocate, both the counsel have made statements that all the terms and conditions of the settlement have been fulfilled and now the parties have no claims/dues towards each other.

In view thereof and keeping in view the law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4)**

RCR Criminal 543 and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, complaint No.265 dated 6.4.2015 under Section 12 of Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, Police Station, Jalandhar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
