Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.14 dated 20.2.2015 under Sections 406/498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners, namely, Chaman Lal and Asha Rani who are parents-in-law of the complainant and aged about 72 years and 65 years respectively, have joined the investigation.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Jaswinder Singh, states that though the petitioners have joined the

investigation but some more dowry articles are required to be recovered from them.

Considering the fact that complainant Sona Jiwan Jyoti @ Sonia was married with Raj Kumar @ Raju i.e. son of the petitioners on 7.11.2004 and the petitioners are old persons, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioners vide order dated 6.5.2015 is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
