Report dated 22.06.2015 sent by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga has been received, whereby, after recording statement of petitioners Davinder Singh Pardhan, Jaspal Singh, Jagdev Singh, Amanjot Singh, Harjinder Singh as well as of complainant Satish Kumar Bansal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a co-employee of the same undertaking and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.27 dated

01.04.2015 under Sections 324,323,148,149 IPC, Police Station, Moga Sadar District Moga and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioner.
