Notice of motion.

On asking of the court, Mr. P.S. Sullar, Addl. A.G, Punjab, who is present in the court accepts notice and submits that intimation by Registry informing of fixation of the petition has already been received and record of the case is available with him.

As per prosecution version, the occurrence in this case took place in two parts. In the first part of the occurrence, which took place on 9.7.2013 at 3.30 p.m. the petitioner is alleged to have caused injury with *spade* on the right hand of the complainant who called his brother. The second part of the occurrence took place on the same day at about 8.00 p.m. when the complainant was sitting in her house with her brother and the petitioner allegedly came there and aimed a shot with country made pistol at complainant but was caught by Sunil brother of complainant and bullet hit the wall.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the charge against the petitioner has been framed for offence punishable under Sections 452/323/307/506 IPC.

Learned State counsel has argued that shell of the bullet was recovered from the spot and country made pistol along with one live cartridge was also recovered on the basis of disclosure statement of petitioner, who was arrested in this case on 10.7.2015. It has been submitted that four prosecution witnesses have since been examined.

In view of the facts and circumstances of the case as discussed above and the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, but without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sonapat.
