Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 368 dated 29.4.2014, under Section 306 read with Section 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, District Gurgaon.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the bare perusal of the suicide note (Annexure P-3) nowhere indicates the involvement of the petitioner. The only allegation against the petitioner is that they have snatched vehicle No.HR-58T-0139 whereas the said vehicle is owned by petitioner itself. He further submits that the petitioner

is in custody since 1.11.2014 and challan has already been submitted. Moreover as against the total 22 cited witnesses, 13 have already been examined and none of the witness has deposed against the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Subhash does not dispute the aforesaid fact and submitted that father and brother of deceased Anoop have become hostile.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 1.11.2014 and 13 witnesses have been examined and no witness has deposed against the petitioner, I admit the petitioner to regular bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

However, it is made clear that the expression made here-in-above shall not be construed any expression on the merits of the case and the learned trial Court is at liberty to conclude the trial on the available evidence/material.

The petition is disposed of.
