Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 119 dated 11.11.2011, under Sections 15/25 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

Custody certificate has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record.

Perusal of the custody certificate reveals that in addition to present FIR, two FIRs i.e. FIR No. 259 dated 09.06.2014, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drgus & Psychotropic Substance Act, registered at Police Station City Nakodar and FIR No. 148 dated 15.12.2012 under
