Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.153 dated 07.04.2015, registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal, under Sections 183/379 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of the Prevention of Damage to the Public Property Act and Section 21(4) (1) of Mines and Mineral Act.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the record.

There are serious allegations against the petitioners that they

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were found stealing the sand from the Western Yamuna Canal in violation of the orders of the District Magistrate and caused damage to the public property. To know about the persons involved in the offence; as well as to know the whereabouts of owners of the tractor-trolley and to recover the registration certificates of the tractors, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is required.

No ground for interference is made out.
