This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail in a case registered against the petitioners under Sections 323, 420, 506, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sector 5, District Panchkula, vide FIR No.34 dated 3.2.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners are in custody since 18.2.2015. Investigation has been completed and challan presented before the competent court on 14.7.2015 and case is triable by Magistrate.

Learned State counsel (on instructions from ASI Brij Pal Singh, who is present in Court) has opposed the prayer for bail on the ground that the allegations against the petitioners are serious. He, however, does not dispute the period of incarceration of the petitioners.

Heard.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the period of incarceration of the petitioners, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioners any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioners are directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.
