Rajinder Kaur and Rahul Singla, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No. 3 to 5 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents no. 3 to 5. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3 and P-4 respectively.

The petitioners have straightway approached this Court without making any representation to the authorities. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners shall approach the SSP Bathinda-respondent No.1 with a representation detailing their grievance.

Without commenting upon the legality of the marriage and entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.1 to decide the representation to be filed by the petitioners, within a period of one month from the date of its filing and grant the protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
