**RAJ MOHAN SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks issuance of necessary directions to respondents No.1 to 4 against illegal harassment by the Police at the instance of respondent No.5.

Learned counsel states that marriage of the petitioner was solemnized with respondent No.5 on 24.10.2010 and a daughter took birth from their wedlock and now she is with the petitioner. Wife left matrimonial house on 27.03.2013 leaving behind child of only 31 days with the petitioner. Complaint filed by the wife was found to be false and she repeatedly kept on going and coming from matrimonial house. The petitioner filed divorce petition on 09.04.2015 and on receiving notice respondent No.5 started harassing the petitioner

with the help of Police to a greater degree. Precisely in this context representation of the petitioner dated 22.04.2015 is pending before respondent No.2.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Varun Sharma, A.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of official respondents. Let a copy of petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of the day.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass no reply is needed.

In view of allegations made hereinabove, present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to have assessment of allegations, and if need be, pass appropriate order in the context of protection of the petitioner and illegal harassment if found proved at the instance of respondent No.5.
