Petitioner Surinder Singh has preferred this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C., seeking regular bail in case FIR No.110 dated 04.07.2014, registered at Police Station Kurali, District S.A.S.Nagar, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. S.S.Chandumajra, DAG, Punjab, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent(s)-State and contested this petition. Police record is also available.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

The petitioner is not named in the FIR and here is no allegation against him in the FIR. As per prosecution version, Labh Singh, brother of complainant, had left the house about 50-60 years back and did not return to home. On 11.02.2014, Nambardar Satwinder Singh alongwith Jaspreet Singh and attesting witness Nachattar Singh, by impersonating, executed the sale deed in respect of share of Labh Singh and thereafter got sanctioned the

loan of Rs.8,60,000/-. The petitioner is in custody since 18.09.2014. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes. As already discussed, the petitioner is not named in the FIR nor any role has been attributed to him. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the disposal of the case.

Therefore, keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and without discussing the facts of the case in minute details and without expressing any opinion on the merit of the case, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of ₹35,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, S.A.S.Nagar.
