Report dated 27.11.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Harpargat Singh @ Balraj Singh as well as of complainants Gurmit Singh, Davinder Kaur, Surinder Singh and Rohit Bhagat it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that it is a pure accidental case and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to sort out the differences between them and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.29 dated 08.02.2012 under Sections 304-A,279,337,338,427 IPC, Police Station, Jandiala Guru,

District Amritsar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the present petitioners.

Petition stands disposed off.
