Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for providing security to the petitioner in case FIR No. 192 dated 15.03.2015, under Sections 302/34 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Gurgaon in which petitioner is an eye witness.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Naveen Sheoran Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and after perusing the paper-book, however, without commenting on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.4 – Commissioner of Police, Gurgaon, to look into the grievance of the petitioner specifically made in representation dated 25.03.2015 (Annexure P/4) and take appropriate action in accordance with law. Since the petitioner is stated to be an eye witness, the police authority shall examine the issue for providing of security to the petitioner and take adequate steps for this purpose.
