Quashing of the FIR No.113 dated 17.04.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Taraori, District Karnal (Annexure P-1) and its consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise dated 26.04.2014 (Annexure P-2), is being sought.

FIR was registered by Malkeet Singh-respondent No.2/complainant with the allegations that on 17.04.2014, about about 2:30 at night petitioners had entered his house through a wall and upon breaking the main lock of his house, caused damage to the T.G., fridge, kitchen articles, iron almira and to the window and door and mirror of his house and also caused damage to the parked motorcycle. Petitioner No.1 caused a sword blow upon him, he rescued by raising the right hand, then

the same had inflicted upon the palm of his right hand. Thereafter, petitioner No.3 caused a gandasi blow on the left side of his waist and other petitioners assault with curtain road and also caused non-visible injuries. Petitioner No.1 also took away the ear ring and gold chain weighing 3 tola of his mother Kamlesh Kaur and Rs.20,000/- kept in the almira.

Now, the matter has amicably been settled between the parties.

In compliance of the order dated 08.09.2014, status report has been received from the Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Karnal. Statements of the parties have been recorded to the effect that a compromise has been affected without pressure, coercion or undue influence between the parties.

Consequently, in view of the status report and in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Madan Mohan Abbot vs. State of Punjab 2008(2) RCR (Criminal) 429**, the law laid down by the Full Bench of this Court in the case of **Kulwinder Singh and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052**, no useful purpose would be served in prolonging the litigation.

Accordingly, FIR No.113 dated 17.04.2014 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Taraori,

District Karnal (Annexure P-1), is quashed with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners.

The petition stands disposed of qua petitioners.
