Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.37 dated 27.3.2015, under Sections 419, 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Harike, District Tarn Taran.

This Court vide order dated 7.5.2015, while issuing notice of motion, has granted interim bail to the petitioner subject to joining the investigation as and when directed by the Investigating Agency/Investigating Officer and to abide by the terms and conditions laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Lakhbir Singh,

has stated that in terms of the above order the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 7.5.2015 are made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
