MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.291 dated 27.10.2014 under Sections 457, 380 IPC at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the the petitioner has been named at the behest of his co-accused and is accused of receiving the stolen property and also pleaded false implication.

Noticing this, the Court had granted the interim protection to the petitioner on 7.5.2015, pursuant to which he has since joined the investigation which fact is not controverted by the learned counsel appearing for the State.

In view of the above, the interim directions dated 7.5.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
