Keeping in view that being a pure matrimonial dispute and that parties have effected a compromise which will go a long way to settle their future life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.81 dated 15.7.2014 under Sections 406 and 498-A IPC Police Station, Women District Ludhiana and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
