MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.35 dated 20.4.2015 under Sections 379/342/427/506/149 IPC at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Noticing the contention of the learned counsel for the petitioner that even if the allegations are taken to be correct then also to safeguard the interest of the complainant he would deposit a sum of Rs.1 lakh, the Court had granted the interim protection to the petitioner on 7.5.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the

matter has now been settled inter se between the parties and a quashing petition bearing No.CRM-M-22610-2015 has been filed.

In view of the above, the interim directions dated 7.5.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
