The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in cross case registered under Sections 307, 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC and 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act in FIR No.71 dated 08.08.2014 registered under Sections 302, 307, 148 and 149 IPC and 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act at Police Station Rangar Nangal, Police District Batala District Gurdaspur.

The allegations against the petitioner are that he is alleged to have given dang blow on one Kuldeep Singh. The facts would indicate a free fight between the petitioner and the complainant in the present FIR. Two persons from the petitioner's side had died in this incident.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the petitioner is in custody since 11.11.2014 and the challan has been submitted. The petitioner has given dang blow on the waist of Kuldeep Singh, which is simple injury.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the bail

application of the petitioner on the ground of serious nature of the incident.

On due consideration of the matter and noticing the limited role of the petitioner in the instant petition and noticing that the petitioner is in custody since 11.11.2014 and the challan has already been submitted, the instant petition is accepted. It is directed that the petitioner be released on bail in terms of Section 439 Cr.PC subject to his furnishing of bail bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.

Nothing said herein shall be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case.
