Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.2 dated 05.01.2015, under Sections 498-A, 406 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Ajnala, District Amritsar Rural.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 07.05.2015:-

“On the oral request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, complainant Bir Kaur daughter of Karnail Singh, resident of village Baltadwal, District Amritsar, is impleaded as respondent No.2. Registry to make necessary correction in the memo of parties.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is the husband of respondent No.2/complainant and there is possibility of compromise between the parties.

Notice of motion for 18.5.2015.

Petitioner is directed to deposit Rs.25,000/- with

Registry as litigation expenses to be paid to respondent No.2. Notice shall be issued subject to deposit of litigation expenses as aforesaid.

In the meantime, to explore the possibility of compromise, petitioner shall not be arrested.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Tarlochan Singh has submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. In the event of arrest, petitioner be admitted to bail subject to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. Petitioner shall join investigation as and when required by the investigating officer and shall not tamper with the prosecution evidence. Petitioner shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court. The amount of ₹25,000/- deposited by the petitioner in pursuance to the order dated 07.05.2015 passed by this Court be released to the respondent No.2 forthwith.
