Learned counsel for the petitioner states that petitioner has already approached respondent No.3 disclosing commission of cognizable offence in terms of Section 154 Cr.P.C, but despite the legal obligations cast upon the authority no action has been taken. Thereafter, petitioner has also moved representation dated 28.04.2015 to respondent No.2, thereby further complying with requirement of Section 154 Cr.P.C.

Petitioner is running a cable business and is paying entertaining tax to Government in pursuance to lawful license issued to him by the competent authority. Respondent No.4 is also alleged to be in same business and is allegedly harassing the petitioner by cutting cable wires and summoning the petitioner with police help.

In view of nature of order which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of filing reply.
