Four accused-petitioners are praying for quashing of FIR No.585 dated 05.11.2014 for offences punishable under Sections 382, 452, 506 and 34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25, 54 & 59 of Arms Act registered with Police Station Sadar Palwal, District Palwal on the basis of compromise dated 01.05.2015 (P-3).

Although a report has been received from the Illaqa Magistrate that statements in terms of the compromise have been recorded of the four petitioners and the complainant, however, a perusal of the FIR reveals that it is one Mahesh who is partner of Toll Plaza against whose interest the offence in reality has been committed. The said Toll Plaza has been taken on lease by a partnership firm for two years and the four petitioners are

alleged to be using the facility without paying any Toll Tax and also allegedly collecting money. They are also alleged to have threatened the employees by showing pistol.

It is apparent that the investigation in this case have not yet been concluded.

At this stage learned Counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
