FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners, Robin Bansal, Tarsem Kumar Bansal and Santosh Bansal who happens to be husband, father-in-law and mother-in-law respectively of the complainant/respondent No.2 Meena Bansal have sought quashing of the FIR (Annexure P1) on the basis of settlement agreement (Annexure P6) arrived at between the husband and wife before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

It has been submitted on behalf of both sides by Dr. Rau. P.S. Girwar, Advocate for the petitioners and Mr. S.K. Jain, Advocate representing the complainant/respondent No.2 that the compromise (Annexure P6) has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

Heard.

In the light of the concurrence shown by both sides, being a pure matrimonial case together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.111 dated 27.09.2014 registered at Police Station City-II Mansa under Sections 498A/406 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
