Report dated 26.8.2015 sent by learned Judicial Magistrate, 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Amritsar has been received, whereby, after recording statement of the petitioners Sanjeev Kumar and Phoola Rani @ Suraksha as well as of complainant Shama @ Komal it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that being a pure matrimonial dispute and that the parties have compromised the matter which will go a long way to settle their future life and to bring about harmonious atmosphere and in view of law laid down in **Gian Singh vs. State of Punjab and another 2012(4) RCR Criminal 543** and **Kulwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another 2007(3) RCR Criminal 1052**, FIR No.60 dated 27.03.2012 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police

Station, Cheharatta Amritsar City and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
