Both the petitioners are present in person and stated to be major and they have not earlier married.

On instructions from petitioner No. 1-Ranjit Kaur who is present in person, learned counsel for petitioners submits that she passed her 10+2 examination in the year 2011. As per affidavit dated 05.05.2015 (Annexure P-1) duly sworn-in by petitioner No. 1, her date of birth is 14.08.1990.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only, at this stage.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Gazi Mohd., DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3.

Let three copies of paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

In view of the limited prayer made in the petition and

without commenting upon the validity of marriage or the correctness of ages, the instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur to look into the allegations contained in representation dated 05.05.2015 (Annexure P-5) and if warranted, take appropriate steps in accordance with law.

It is made clear that if a complaint for criminal offence or an FIR is pending, this order shall not cause any hindrance in those proceedings.
