FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Report dated 02.07.2015 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st

Class, Jalandhar has been received whereby after recording statements of complainant Kuldeep Kaur wife of Kulwinder Singh and the accused persons namely Amandeep Kaur, Pritpal Singh, Boota Singh and Kuldeep Kaur widow of Davinder Singh, the Court has shown its satisfaction that the compromise has been arrived at voluntarily, out of free will of the parties, without any undue influence,

coercion or pressure and which is also based on the compromise deed Mark-A.

Heard.

In the light of the satisfaction shown by the Court, being a pure land dispute between the parties and the fact that offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in resolving the personal dispute and in bringing about peace and harmony and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.68 dated 09.07.2010 registered at Police Station New Baradari, Jalandhar under Sections 406/420/120-B IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
