JASPAL SINGH, J.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for quashing of FIR No. 209, dated 13.10.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising out of the same, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate has been received, in which, it has been categorically observed that compromise has been entered into between the petitioner/accused and complainant/respondent No.2 voluntarily, out of free will and without any pressure or coercion and same appears to be genuine one. Even

otherwise, the matter involved is personal in nature, which has been amicably put at rest.

So, in view of above circumstances and in view of pronouncement reported as Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another; 2012(4) RCR(Criminal) 543, I am of the considered opinion that continuation of criminal proceedings between the parties would be an abuse of the process of law and the present compromise is for their benefit and will bring peace and harmony between them.

Consequently, the instant petition stands allowed and FIR No. 209, dated 13.10.2012, under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner.
