This petition has been moved by Sunny under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.258 dated 20.11.2013 registered under Sections 363/366-A/120-B IPC and Section 3/4 of Protection of Children from Sexual Offence Act at Police Station City-1, Abohar, District Fazilka.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.12.2013. The allegations against him are that he had helped his brother-in-law Deepak with whom the girl, namely, Arshdeep Kaur had run away. The statement of girl made in Court as a prosecution witness shows that she had levelled the allegations mainly against Deepak stating that he had taken her to different places and established physical relations with her against her wishes. Against the present petitioner, she simply stated that he had taken her to the place where Deepak was standing. Deepak, the main accused is already on bail.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/ Duty Magistrate.
