Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.108 dated 06.11.2014, registered at Police Station Mehna, District Moga, under Sections 399/402 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 25/54/59 of the Arms Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that charge has been framed and the petitioner has been behind bars since 06.11.2014. Similarly situated co-accused have already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 21.04.2015 passed in CRM-M-7132-2015, CRM-M-7578-

2015 and CRM-M-7886-2015 and the petitioner is entitled to bail on the ground of parity. The petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case as well as the fact that similarly situated co-accused have already been granted regular bail by this Court and also the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Moga.
