Petitioner filed a complaint under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana for a direction for registration of FIR. The learned Magistrate instead of issuing a direction has taken up the complaint under Section 200 Cr.P.C. and desired the complainant to lead his preliminary evidence.

After going through the impugned order, I do not find any illegality or impropriety in the steps taken by the learned Magistrate. No ground is made out at this stage for any interference.

Petition is dismissed with prejudice to the rights of the petitioner to establish by preliminary evidence the prima facie commission of alleged offence against the private respondents.
