Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.129 dated 22.04.2014, under Sections 498-A, 323, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sector 40, Gurgaon, District Gurgaon.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 05.05.2014:-

In the meantime, the petitioner shall appear before the Investigating Officer on 12.5.2014 at 11.00 a.m. and join the investigation. In the event of his arrest, he be admitted to interim bail by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer to his satisfaction. He shall, however, abide by all the conditions as envisaged by Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Assistant Sub Inspector Hari Krishan, has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 05.05.2014, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
