This is the third petition filed by the petitioner for the grant of regular bail, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 31.7.2014 while the second dismissed as not pressed on 28.11.2014.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind the bars for the last about 1½ years. The trial of the case has not made any significant progress.

After obtaining instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, learned State counsel has informed the Court that out of the twelve witnesses cited by the prosecution, five have already been examined while five given up, only two witnesses remain to be examined and now the trial is fixed for 10.6.2015.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to expedite the trial and conclude the same preferably, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of the order.
