Petitioner seeks regular bail in FIR No.61 dated 10.04.2009 under Sections 323/324/148/149 IPC, Police Station Baghapurana.

Petitioner was declared as proclaimed person on account of his non-appearance in the Court on 28.02.2014. Earlier to that petitioner was granted regular bail. The petitioner surrendered in Court on 23.02.2015 and is still in custody.

Without commenting upon the absence of accused, at this stage, it will be appropriate to grant regular bail to him particularly in view of fact that he is in custody since 23.02.2015 and offences are triable by Magistrate.

Let the petitioner be enlarged on bail, subject to furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga.
