MAHESH GROVER, J.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. praying for release of the petitioner on bail in terms thereof in a case registered vide FIR No.35 dated 20.4.2015 under Sections 379/342/427/506/149 IPC at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner had contended that in connected petitions bearing Nos.CRM-M-14803 and 14825 of 2015, a sum of Rs.1 lakh was ordered to be deposited for the loss caused on account of forcible harvesting of the crop.

Noticing this, the Court had granted the interim protection to the petitioner on 13.5.2015.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the

matter has now been settled inter se between the parties and a quashing petition bearing No.CRM-M-22610-2015 has been filed.

In view of the above, the interim directions dated 13.5.2015 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner continues to comply with the provisions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands allowed.
