Report dated 24.12.2014 sent by the learned Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Rupnagar has been received, whereby, after recording statements of petitioner Mohammad Akbar @ Soni as well as of complainant Baljinder Kaur it has been informed that the parties have effected a compromise voluntarily on their free will and accord without any pressure.

Keeping in view that the dispute apparently is over money which has been received as per this compromise by the aggrieved party and that this compromise will go a long way to sort out the differences between the parties and to bring about harmonious atmosphere, FIR No.125 dated 13.12.2012 under Sections 406,420,506 IPC Police Station, Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
