PARAMJEET SINGH, J.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.57 dated 12.11.2014, registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 IPC at Police Station SGN Dev Thermal Plant Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since 19.03.2015. Learned counsel further contends that investigation in this case has been completed and the challan has already been presented. Even out of 17 prosecution witnesses cited, only one witness has been examined so far.

Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that trial would not be concluded in near future, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds, to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
