1. Whether reporters of local newspapers may be allowed to see judgment?
2. To be referred to reporters or not?
3. Whether the judgment should be reported in the Digest?

Pursuant to the order dated 13.02.2015, Gurjinder Kaur and Sarabjit Singh who are petitioners in this case, are present in person in the Court, today. Respondent No.4 is also present in person who has been identified by Shri Anoop Singla, Advocate.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner No.1, namely Gurjinder Kaur, has made a statement before the police that she does not have any threat perceptions from respondents No.4 to 7. However, learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners may have threat perceptions in future.

Present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sangrur to look into the matter and to extend protection as permissible under law.

However, it is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the validity of the marriage.
