This is a petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking regular bail to petitioner in a case registered against him vide FIR No.70 dated 19.12.2014 under Sections 452/307/326/324/323 and 506 IPC at Police Station Qadian, Gurdaspur.

Petitioner is stated to be in custody since March 21, 2015. According to learned counsel, head injury i.e. fracture on parital bone is attributed to co-accused Sardar Singh and not the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has opposed the prayer for bail. According to him, charge has been framed and trial has commenced.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and period of incarceration of the petitioner, I am of the considered view that no useful purpose will be served by detaining the petitioner any longer. The trial may take long time to conclude. Thus, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Gurdaspur.
