Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.12 dated 08.04.2015, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Non Resident Indian PS, District Moga.

While issuing notice of motion, following order was passed by this Court on 08.05.2015:-

“Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner seeks to settle the dispute amicably with the complainant.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashish Gupta, Advocate, who is present in the Court, put in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of complainant.

List on 11.08.2015.

In the meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police and join investigation within a week. In the event of her arrest being required, she shall be released on interim bail till the next date, subject to her furnishing bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, she shall abide by the terms and conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)(i) to (iv) Cr.P.C. failing which she shall lose the benefit of anticipatory bail allowed to her.”

Learned State counsel who is assisted by Sub Inspector Naveen Kumar has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for further investigation.

Accordingly, interim bail granted by this Court to the petitioner vide order dated 08.05.2015, is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
