Petitioner seeks pre-arrest bail in FIR No.135 dated 29.11.2011 under Sections 315 & 201 IPC, Sections 4 & 5 of the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 and Section 29 of the Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques (Regulation & Prevention of Misuse) Act, registered at Police Station Modal Town, District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from HC Jagjit Singh, Police Station Modal Town, Ludhiana, submits that in the present case since cancellation report has been prepared, petitioner is no more required for the purpose of any further investigation.

In view of the above, instant petition is allowed and the order dated 08.05.2015 passed by this Court is hereby made absolute, however, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
